

**Questions for consideration by donors in preparing for meetings of the Standing Committee  
on Victim Assistance and Socio-Economic Reintegration**

1. *What is your State's approach to the need to ensure that resources are provided to support those States that need assistance in the care and rehabilitation of landmine survivors?*
2. *If your State does not have a specific funding mechanism for victim assistance, in what other ways does it support programmes that would benefit landmine survivors (or persons with disabilities generally) in countries that require assistance ( e.g., support for enhancing medical care and rehabilitation services)?*
3. *Through a consultative process that was facilitated at the request of the Co-Chairs in 2001-2002, four areas for assistance were identified as priorities by both landmine survivors and mine affected States Parties: emergency care and continuing medical care; rehabilitation, prosthetics and assistive devices; employment and socio-economic reintegration; and, legislation and national planning. How has the provision of resources by your State assisted efforts in these areas?*
4. *In which States have you supported programmes that would benefit landmine survivors and through which means (e.g., direct bilateral contributions; support to the initiatives of non-governmental or international organizations; through regional or international funding mechanisms, et cetera)?*
