Portugal continued its cooperation with Mozambique regarding landmines clearance and disposal, namely by granting access to maps and relevant cartography, of which copies were made available to the Authorities of Mozambique.

In this context, a delegation of Mozambique from the National Demining Institute visited the Portuguese Tropical Research Institute (IICT), an R&D public institution which holds a vast cartographic archive (Overseas Historical Archive), as well as the Archives of the Ministry of National Defence.
