## 1. Status of programs for destruction of stockpiled APMs (Article 4)

| The process of anti-personnel mines (APMs) destruction was divided into two phases. The first one lasted until the end of 2012. During this stage the first part of APMs and their components were transported to four central storage facilities. APMs were decommissioned, dismantled and destroyed in these places.  The second and final part of the operation was started in 2013 when the remaining APMs and APMs components were gathered in five central storage facilities where they were waiting for demilitarization. In 2015 all of them were transferred from Poland to Germany for the purpose of destruction. The Military Property Agency was the institution authorised by the government of Poland for this transfer. All remaining APMs and APMs components were demilitarized and destroyed by German contractor. | Location of destruction sites | Description of the status of programs including: |
