¹ Notes on using the cover page:

1. In the year 2011 the Netherlands spent an amount of 10.486.403 Euros to NGO's DDG, HALO, Handicap, MAG, NPA and Geneva Call. Through UNMAS the Dutch contribution in 2011 totalled 6 million USD. An indicative overview of the Netherlands contributions to mine action in the year 2011 is stated below. Most of these funds are intended for mine clearing operations ; a smaller part is devoted to victim assistance and mine education.
