

**Enabled CNIDAH to set a more balanced BASELINE** with the reality of the actual contamination.







"Current Baseline" for SHAs and / or contaminated:


That compared with baseline submmitted in the extension request , 793.177.246,68 m<sup>2</sup> (about 793km <sup>2</sup>- seven hundred and ninety three square kilometers) an update with an increase of 50% of the suspected areas.
