### ISU Financial Update - 11 April 2014i

#### 2013 Finances

- The ISU's expenditures for 2013 were approximately CHF 45,000, or approximately 5 per cent, below budgeted projections. (The savings can largely be attributed to lower than expected costs for consultants / consultants' travel.)
- Even though the ISU underspent relative to budgeted costs, the ISU ended the year with a small deficit of approximately CHF 19,631, which will have to be covered in 2014.
- Twenty-six (26) States Parties contributed to the ISU's 2013 core costs: Albania, Algeria, Australia, Austria, Bulgaria, Cambodia, Chile, Colombia, Cyprus, Denmark, Estonia, Germany, Hungary, Iraq, Indonesia, Ireland, Italy, Jordan, Mexico, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Slovenia, Sweden, Switzerland and Turkey.
- The deficit would have been greater except that the ISU was permitted to transfer approximately CHF 21,000 in unspent funds from Australia (for an initiative specifically targeting the Pacific) to the ISU's core budget. The possibility of this injection of additional funds from any source is not expected in 2014.

#### 2014 Finances

- The ISU's 2014 budget, approved by the 13MSP, estimates expenditures totalling CHF 977,293. When this is combined with the negative carry-over from 2013 (CHF 19,631), a total of 996,924 are required in 2014.
- To date, funds received from Algeria, Argentina, Austria, Jordan, Ireland and South Africa, and contracted / committed by Australia, France and Denmark total approximately CHF 286,761.
   Approximately CHF 710,000 are still required.
- The Eleventh Meeting of the States Parties "encouraged...work to improve the present (voluntary) funding model and to ensure sufficient contributions are provided to the ISU as long as the financing model remains unchanged." On 27 January 2014, the President of the Thirteenth Meeting of the States Parties wrote to all States Parties to invite each State Party to direct its 2014 financial contribution to the ISU as soon as possible.

- Of note regarding 2014 activities, the ISU has been under extraordinary pressure given the unforeseen intensity of efforts to prepare the Maputo Review Conference and the consequent demand by delegations for ISU support.
- Also of note, the ISU has been under extraordinary pressure given the need to support an Article 5 extensions request and analysis process which must fit into a 6.5 month period rather than the normal 12 month period.
