

Media Accreditation Requirements*

Media professionals wishing to attend the *Maputo Review Conference on a Mine-Free World* are asked to register on line at www.maputoreviewconference.org in order to receive accreditation.

In addition,

1. All media professionals based in Mozambique are asked to provide their press ID number
2. Independent, freelance journalists and bloggers based in Mozambique but without a press ID card are asked to provide:
 - a. A letter explaining the journalist's interest in covering the Maputo Review Conference.
 - b. A link or a copy of at least two previously published stories which have appeared in media outlets or blogs that provide a substantial amount of original news content, commentary or analysis.
 - c. A copy of their Mozambican national ID card or foreign resident's card.
3. Media professionals including bloggers, independent and freelance journalists based outside Mozambique are asked to provide:
 - a. A copy of their passport and press ID card in electronic format.
 - b. If no press ID card is available, please send a link or a copy of at least two previously published stories which have appeared in media outlets or blogs that provide a substantial amount of original news content, commentary or analysis.

The above information / documents should be provided to the *Maputo Review Conference* Communications Unit at: press@apminebanconvention.org

Note: The Communications Unit must be satisfied that the individuals applying for accreditation are bona fide media professionals. Media accreditation is not accorded to the information outlets of States, international and non-governmental organizations. These individuals should register as part of the official delegation.

Once your request is accepted, you will receive an email confirming your registration and in the case of journalists residing outside Mozambique, a courtesy visa will be awarded to you.

Bring the confirmation letter with you to the Press Desk located at the **Girassol Indy Congress Conference Centre**, Rua Macombe Nongué-Nongué, R.1.373 – Sommerschild in Maputo.
