

THIRD REVIEW CONFERENCE OF THE STATES PARTIES TO THE CONVENTION ON THE PROHIBITION OF THE USE, STOCKPILING, PRODUCTION AND TRANSFER OF ANTI-PERSONNEL MINES AND ON THEIR DESTRUCTION

MAPUTO, 23-27 JUNE 2014

INFORMATION FOR PARTICIPANTS^{*}

1. Venue

The Maputo Review Conference will take place from 23 to 27 June at the Girassol Indy Congress Conference Centre.

2. Opening ceremony

All delegates are invited to an opening ceremony on Sunday 22 June at 17:30 at the Polana Hotel. The ceremony will run until 18:30 and will be followed by a reception.

3. Timing of plenary sessions

Plenary sessions will be held each day on Monday 23, Tuesday 24, Thursday 26 and Friday 27 June from 09:00 to 12:00 and from 14:00 to 17:00. While there will be no plenary sessions on Wednesday 25 June, heads of delegations are invited to Mozambique's national day celebrations that morning and up to 10 side events will take place that day between 12:00 and 17:00.

4. High level segment

A high level segment will begin at 14:00 on Thursday 26 June and run all day (if necessary) on Friday 27 June. Each delegation may address the conference during the high level segment. In keeping with the practice used at the First and the Second Review Conferences, after each high level delegate speaks, she or he will be escorted to a separate room to sign a ceremonial copy of the Maputo +15 declaration and to participate in a photo opportunity.

5. Registration

Registration involves two steps:

- a. Each delegation must officially notify the Executive Secretary of the Third Review Conference (i.e. Peter Kolarov of the UNODA: aplc@unog.ch) of the composition of its delegation;

In accordance with Article 12 of the Convention, States Parties present at the Maputo Review Conference are considered "Participants". Other States, relevant international organizations or institutions, regional organizations, the International Committee of the Red Cross, the International Federation of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies, the Sovereign Order of Malta, the International Campaign to Ban Landmines (ICBL), and the Geneva International Centre for Humanitarian Demining may attend as "Observers".

Member organizations of the ICBL that wish to take part in the Maputo Review Conference should contact ICBL office in Geneva, which will collect necessary information from prospective ICBL delegates and forward it to the Executive Secretary. Please contact the ICBL at 3rc@icblcmc.org for more information.

Other organizations may request to attend as "Observers", subject to approval of the Conference. According to the rules of procedure, organisations other than those explicitly listed in the rules may attend the Maputo Review Conference if recommended by the Coordinating Committee and if approved by the Review Conference. Interested organizations should contact the Executive Secretary. In considering whether to recommend such requests, the Convention's Coordinating Committee takes into consideration criteria such as whether the proposed observer is a non-profit entity and whether its purpose and activities are consistent with the object and purpose of the Convention.

Organizations / individuals wishing to attend without Official Observer Status may still do so as, according to the rules of procedure, the Maputo Review Conference will be held in public. For security reasons, individuals wishing to attend the Maputo Review Conference must still complete online registration in order to receive access to the conference venue.

7. Visas

The Government of Mozambique will waive visa requirements to registered delegates. Upon completion of the registration process, the Government of Mozambique will send registered delegates an official letter confirming their registration and the receipt of a visa waiver upon arrival in Mozambique.

In addition, delegates may obtain a courtesy visa in countries where the Government of Mozambique has consulates. If possible, delegates are encouraged to apply at the Mozambican consulate in their country of residence. 8. Hotels

The Government of Mozambique has negotiated rates with a number of hotels in Maputo. Detailed information can be found attached.

9. Arrivals

Starting on Saturday 21 June, Conference volunteers will welcome all participants arriving at the Maputo International Airport. Delegates will be provided with transportation from the airport to the hotels listed below.

10. Transportation

Buses will travel to and from the hotels listed below and the conference centre each day. Buses will travel from the conference centre to the airport on Friday afternoon and evening. Prearranged transport from hotels to the airport will be available on Saturday 28 June 2014. All delegates must carry conference accreditation to use this free transportation.

Delegates staying in hotels or guesthouses not listed above are welcome to travel to the nearest hotel listed to make use of the transportation provided.

Additional transportation needs and costs are the responsibility of the delegates.

12. Side Events

Up to five side events will take place each day from 23 to 27 June (including on Wednesday 25 June) from 12:00 to 14:00. In addition, up to five additional side events will take place on Wednesday 25 June from 14:00 to 17:00.

13. Working Languages

In keeping with the Convention's practices, simultaneous interpretation during plenary sessions will be available in Arabic, Chinese, English, French, Russian and Spanish. In addition, interpretatoin in Portuguese, the national language of Mozambique, will also be provided.

14. Communications.

Wi-fi is available in the conference centre. A number of computers will be made available to delegates in delegates' lounge area.

The voltage in Mozambique is 220V. The sockets are for standard two pin plugs.
