To: The Permanent Missions to the United Nations in Geneva of States Parties and States not party to the Convention on the Prohibition of the Use, Stockpiling, Production and Transfer of Anti-Personnel Mines and on Their Destruction

Excellencies, dear friends,

The Convention on the Prohibition of the Use, Stockpiling, Production and Transfer of Anti-Personnel Mines and on Their Destruction is the cornerstone of the international effort to end the suffering and casualties caused by anti-personnel mines. The overwhelming success of this Convention is a testimony to the hard work carried out by States in collaboration with Civil Society.

At the Maputo Review Conference in June 2014 the States Parties collectively made a call to ensure that there are no new mine victims in areas under our jurisdiction or control, to see that survivors participate in their societies on an equal basis to others, and to intensify our efforts to complete our respective time-bound obligations to the fullest extent possible by 2025. The last stretch will require the strengthening of our joint commitment and resolve.

It is therefore a great honor for the Presidency to invite you to take part in the following event:
