1. Hazardous areas situation – January 2014

- 130 SHAs (1'823'292m²) : Survey report 2012
- ARU (ITURI) and DUNGU (Haut-Uele) : two territories not surveyed in 2012
- One major security challenge in the northeastern part of DRC covering the affected Territories of BENI and ITURI

REMARKS

Some data used during NLCS has been updated, the 130 area in NLCS had a total of 1'823'292m², after verification, it appeared that the right number is 2'126'763m² (+303'471m²). Some zones didn't have the correct area.







7. Pollution map






Mine Risk Education per Gender 2014-2017

Victims per Gender 2014-2017




