

Cyprus Extension Request – ICBL Comments

19th Meeting of States Parties to the Mine Ban Treaty, 15-19 November 2021

Thank you, Mr. President,

The ICBL thanks Cyprus for submitting its request in a timely manner and for providing additional information on the efforts undertaken towards fulfillment of its Art. 5 obligations, since its last extension request. We also thank the Article 5 Committee for it analysis.

We fully support Cyprus's request. By requesting an extended deadline for these mined areas, Cyprus ensures its continued compliance with Art. 5 and upholds the integrity of the convention.

We also take the opportunity to recall the <u>Security Council Resolution 2561</u> of January 2021 which "urges the leaders of <u>both</u> communities to agree and continue a plan of work to achieve a mine-free Cyprus."

We continue to hope for a prompt settlement of the situation and for land to become safe again for communities in the near future.
