- Progress creates its own challenges








Access to prostheses and rehabilitation

Basic human needs and rehabilitation







Rehabilitation in Healthcare: Attainable rights, or return to the medical model of disability?

- Disability as the result of a physical condition that is part of the person
- Disability as defined by experts, not as understood by the individual survivor
- Classification, labeling, and measurement:

"degrees of disability" rather than functioning

What about the money?

 MBT and CCM Article 6: each State Party "in a position to do so" shall provide assistance for VA

• CRPD Article 32: International Cooperation to further national efforts

• CCW, Protocol V, Article 8

Sustainability

- -long-term capacity building, committment to this
- -Mix of funding sources to support appropriate assistance
- -more efforts to transfer (ownership) of physical rehab to governments Scapacity & responsibility
 - -commitment by affected states to dedicate
- linking victim assistance to other development
