Taking this opportunity, we would like to reiterate that our country is determined to fulfil its commitments emanating from the Ottawa Convention.

We continue to cooperate with ASEAN Regional Mine Action Center (ARMAC).

Our voluntary financial contributions to the functioning of this forum have been consistent over the years.

In this vein, two weeks ago, we have already transferred our contribution to support the ISU budget in 2022. We call for all States Parties to contribute to mine action, including to the work of the Implementation Support Unit, which is critical to the functioning of the Convention.
