

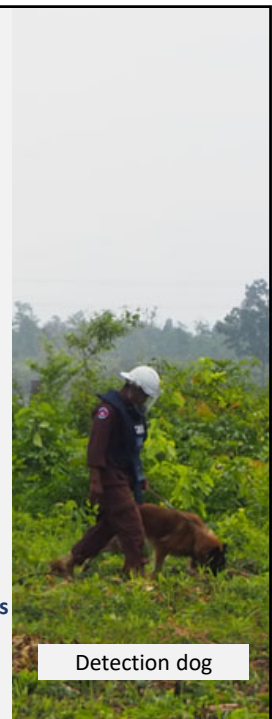
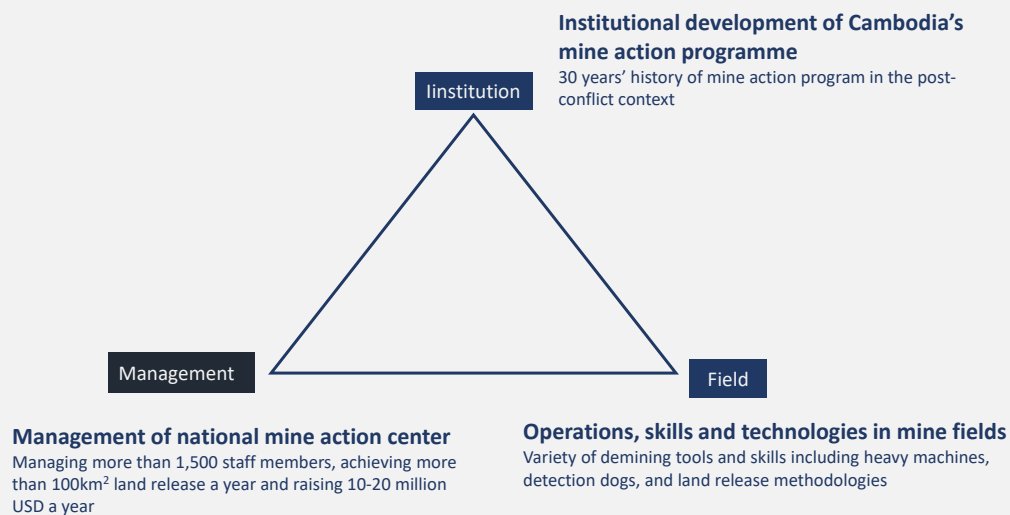

Training focusing on specific skill and knowledge such as heavy machine, EOD 3+ and detection dog


Oversea operation
