



LAW OF UKRAINE "ON MINE ACTION IN UKRAINE"

ARTICLE 10 OF THE LAW OF UKRAINE "ON MINE ACTION IN UKRAINE" :
provides for the provision of medical, psychological, professional and social assistance to victims of explosive ordnance.

● **THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH**
ensures

- *medical care*
- *medical services*

● **MINISTRY OF SOCIAL POLICY**
ensures

- *one-time monetary compensation and annual healthcare allowance;*
- *free psychological and medical-psychological rehabilitation*
- *giving to the injured children priority places in pre-school education institutions*
- *payments to the injured children social assistance (under the age of 18)*

LAW OF UKRAINE "ON THE STATUS OF WAR VETERANS AND GUARANTEES OF THEIR SOCIAL PROTECTION"

ARTICLE 7:

Persons injured by explosive objects belong to persons with disabilities

THESE PERSONS OBTAIN SOCIAL BENEFITS:

— cash payments

— providing of medicines

— social, labor and vocational rehabilitation

— household services

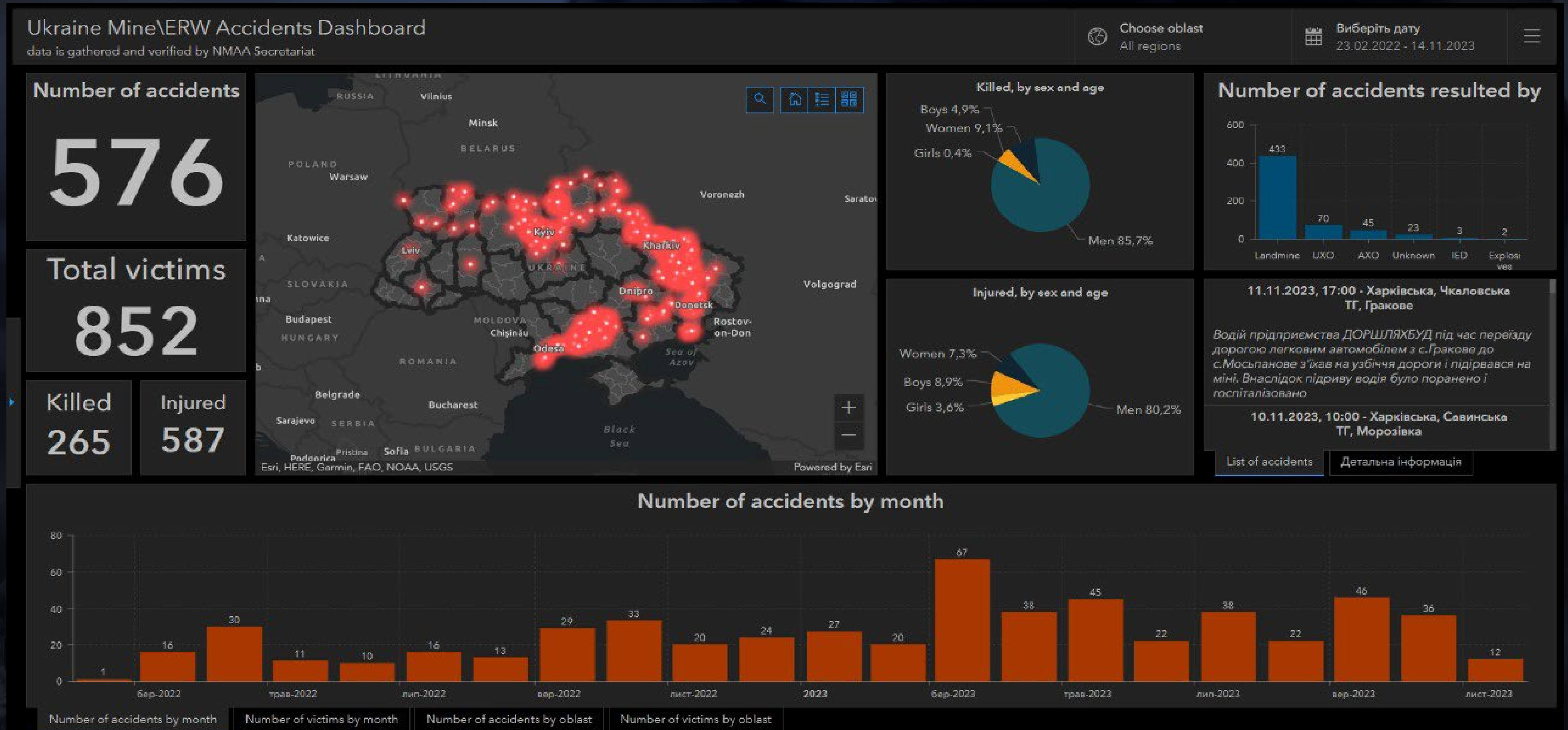
— free of charge transportation by public transport

— reimbursement of utility bills

— annual medical examination

PROVIDING PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSISTANCE

ARTICLE 38 OF THE CIVIL PROTECTION CODE OF UKRAINE:

Psychological service of the State Emergency Service of Ukraine (SES) provides psychological assistance to victims in affected areas, including SES employees and civilians affected by explosive remnants of war
