





#### Assistance to Mrs Ana José Capagaio (caseb study)



On October 5, 2021, Capagaio was looking for firewood in a mined area, in the town of Mussafu, Municipality of Libolo, triggered the anti-personnel mine and lost her left leg. She is a widow and mother of three children. In May of this year, Journalist Kristin Palitza from a German news outlet interviewed Mrs. Capagaio. Months later, Kristin made a donation of Euro 500.00.

The donation was formally delivered to Mrs Capagaio by APOPO, in the presence of members of the Local Administration.
